### *Attended Services – Interment*

Our vessel can accommodate up to 80 guests for services. The Captain sails to the area of interment and oversees the ceremony. We provide three flowers to place in the water. Our photographer can take photos if you desire. We have non-denominational ordained ministers on staff to preside over the interment of your love one if desired. Catered and non-catered services are available.



### *Non- Attended Internment*

Our Captain and non-denominational clergy are trained to carry out a committal service with the highest level of professionalism. The Captain and clergy will perform the ceremony with the same dignity and respect if the service was attended.

### *Service Certificate*

Our captain and non-denominational clergy person will provide a certificate that includes the latitude and longitude of the interment, time and date. The certificate will be signed by the US Coast Guard licensed Captain, and our Non-Denominational clergy person. It will be mailed to you in a timely manner.

### *Frequently Asked Questions*

#### **Once I contact your company, who will handle the arrangements?**

We have highly-trained, compassionate coordinators ready to assist you with every aspect of the process.

#### **Can I attend the service?**

Yes. We allow additional passengers (we can also provide a clergy person).

#### **Do I have to attend the service?**

No, your presence is not required. The Captain and Non-Denominational clergy will perform the service according to your wishes and you will receive a certificate.

#### **Once the service is completed, will I receive any documentation?**

Our captain and clergy person will issue a certificate documenting the date and exact location of the service. We will forward the certificate to your attention.

#### **What happens during the winter months?**

Our vessel remains in the water for the winter. We will try and accommodate your request.

#### **What are the requirements for transporting my loved one's remains?**

Your funeral director can review options with you, as they vary. You may choose to have the remains placed in an urn, or in another container of your choosing. Bio-degradable containers are acceptable, but not required.
